How can I participate?

OLMUN offers a variety of ways to participate and to experience different aspects of the conference. While most participants are delegates, it is also possible to participate as Staff (Administrative, TV, Photography or Technical) or as a Journalist. Applications for these roles are open until March 15th.

Which committees will be simulated at OLMUN?

Ten committees are simulated: the GA1st, GA2nd, ECOSOC, UN Women, UNEP, UNHRC, UNESCO, WHA, UNSpC and the Security Council. Each committee will feature a guest speaker to provide additional insights into their respective topics. Additionally, there will be lobbying processes and discussions on draft resolutions.



















Are all committees located in the same building?

No. While our committee's locations are distributed all over the city of Oldenburg, each of them is easily accessible by public transportation or even easier by bike. You will be informed about the whereabouts of each committee in the beginning of your stay. During your free time, you can explore the beautiful townscape of Oldenburg with its historical buildings and beautiful parks.

Are there any socializing activities?

Yes, of course there are! As much as we are committed to host progressive and serious committee sessions, we are also promoting the 'OLMUN spirit' by organizing evening activities everyone can participate in. Therefore, we will organize three evening activities, such as the barbecue on Tuesday or the party on Thursday. Each participant will get the chance to connect with students from all over the world and to enjoy the unique atmosphere of the conference.

Where can I stay during the conference?

During the past years OLMUN has maintained a close partnership with local hotels. Should you require accommodation, we would be happy to assist you. We also offer a Housing Programme, which is for international students only. Furthermore, local transportation tickets will be available for purchase. You will receive more information during the application progress.

How do I get to Oldenburg?

Oldenburg is easily accessible by train. Alternatively, the nearest international airports are located at Bremen, Hannover, and Hamburg (50-180 km).

How much will the fees be?

The conference fee is 40€ per delegate. The fee includes lunch and a small dinner on the first day and snacks throughout the whole week as well as all documents required for participation. Additionally, each participant will receive a Survival Pack with useful equipment for the conference at the beginning.
