

German Exchange Programme in Partnership with Sanctor High and Willow Academy at Grootkloof Education Centre

The Environmental Education Staff at Groot Kloof Education Centre hosted members of the German exchange programme on Friday, March 13, 2026. Learners were welcomed to the centre by staff and then embarked on a 1.3km educational hike at the Grootkloof Nature Reserve in Cannon Street, Hillside.

While on the hike educators pointed out indigenous plants with medicinal properties as well as the land use history of the nature reserve. Learners were also given a tour of the indigenous plant nursery at the Grootkloof Nature Reserve and how plants are propagated. After the nursery tour and educational hike, learners participated in fun, interactive games to build camaraderie amongst learners. The hike and games were followed by an educational talk by Mr Edmund Stuurman about the history and heritage of the Khoi people.
